Model resolution for co-ordinated strike action to defend public sector pensions.

We call on workers across the trade union movement to pass the following motion in your union branch, workplace, student union or anti-cuts campaign as soon as possible. The TUC has stated that joint union action is the way to stop the cuts. This policy needs to be turned into a reality. We should bombard the TUC (info@tuc.org.uk) and union leaders with demands for action now:

"This [name of TU body etc] is opposed to every cut in the £81 billion austerity package demanded by this millionaire ConDem government. We believe that these cuts will only be defeated by powerful union action led by the trade unions, together with wider campaigning and alliance-building among service users, welfare claimants, students, pensioners and others. The government's proposals for changes to public sector pensions represents a massive attack on these workers.

We applaud those unions who took strike action on June 30th which involved 750,000 workers. These unions have indicated that they will now be striking in November.
